
GFCD PRAYER, FASTING & CONSECRATION *JANUARY 2-22, 2023*

Our theme scripture for the Year of 2023 is found in...Luke 1:37 (KJV)

"For with God nothing shall be impossible"

We are believing God to bless us because we will release our **Faith** for God to perform the "**Impossible**" in this season.

(I am asking each of you to sow a financial seed gift of): \$153.00 as the goal is to raise \$15,000.00 for a first fruit offering. I believe the Lord is leading us towards building a New House for Worship that we may be able to grow and expand the ministry. My prayer is that each of you share the responsibility to grow, mature and help expand the ministry beyond the four walls of the church building.

I believe with God all things are Possible and sowing a seed represents how much you can believe God for the impossible to be made possible in the same season! The SAME SEASON... that's Possible to believe God for a turnaround in the SAME SEASON!

*Please allow me to intrigue your spiritual senses. 2023 is very significant as it has spiritual value and biblical meaning in the (#23). The numbers 23 mean, "God (is) with Us." The Bible says in Matthew 1:23 (KJV) "Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us" (Isa. 7:14). - 6:30 PM each night (In the Sanctuary)

Read this section carefully

Fasting times are stated:

We will Fast WITHOUT food for (9 hrs.) each day starting at 6AM until 3PM.

Natural food is good for the body, and Spiritual food is good for the soul.

After you have fed your natural man, don't forget to feed your spirit man with prayer, read/study the word and worship!

During the Consecration Sunday Morning Prayer times will begin at 6am-7am. All of GFCD are encouraged to be on prayer line.

....I am humbling petitioning the ENTIRE GFCD FAMILY to commit to keeping the Fast and prayer times.

So, what do we eat during the consecration? I'm glad you asked! It's more like what you CANNOT HAVE!

You CANNOT have:

No sugar, sweets, or deserts; No bread; No sodas of any kind... No diet sodas and No candy for the duration of the Consecration.

Medications:

Those that take medication should use precautions and your Doctor's advice before starting this type of Fast.

Inclement Weather:

At any time during the Consecration should we experience "Inclement Weather" we will convene on the Prayer Line via Zoom.

2 Timothy 4:1-5...(KJV) Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all long-suffering and doctrine. 3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; 4 And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables. 5 But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.

Amen

Romans 15:5-6...(KJV) Now the God of patience and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another according to Christ Jesus: 6 That ye may with one mind and one mouth glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 3:14-21...(KJV) For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, 15 Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, 16 That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man; 17 That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, 18 May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; 19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

20 Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us, 21 Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen.

Matthew 6:9-15...(KJV) After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. 10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. 11 Give us this day our daily bread. 12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. 13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen. 14 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: 15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

Do not share openly with outsiders concerning your consecration; it keeps the door shut to the enemy and temptation of the flesh!

We know that many work, go to school and have family to look after of; however, let's do our best to be on time for corporate prayer times. May God Bless and keep you; May He hear and answer your prayer and petitions while on this consecration.

My prayer is for the Saints at GFCD to take advantage of the Word of God that is being deposited into your lives at every opportunity God fills the mouth of your Leader. Use this season we have been waiting on to win the lost in our family, friends and loved ones.
